About the Hadith

(The day of your fast is the day of your slaughter)

The question:

A person from the virtues people who are subscribed in this honorable magazine asked about a hadith that is commonly said: "the day of your fast is the day of your slaughter", is it a saying of the prophet –peace be upon him–?

The answer:

This hadith has no base according to the consensus of the hadith scholars, and Imam Ahmad declared that and others did too; like Az– Zrkshy and As–Soyoty as in "Kashf Al–Khafa'" for shaykh Isma'il Al– 'ajlony (2/398 no. 3263) and as for his saying: "it was overlooked by As–Sakhawy" because he forgot it, or it is in accordance to the version he received from "Al–Makased Al–Hasanah", because he (As–Sakhawy) did mention it in this book (page 480 no. 1355 Al–Khangy) where he said: "It has no origin, as Imam Ahmad and others said." And Among those who asserted that this hadith has no orgin; Al–Hafiz Ibn Hajar in "Sharh 'eloom Al–Hadith" (page 224) and he quoted from Muhammad bin Abdulallah bin 'Abdul Hakam –Trustworthy Jurist from the companions of Malik– that he said: "It's from the talk of liars." Az– Zrkshy also narrated it in "Al–La'ale' Al–Manthorah" (page 7 from my

two scripts) from the handwriting of Ibn As-Salaah from Ibn Abd Al-Hakam and he approved it. And my greetings to the questioner, and the mercy and blessings of Allah,
